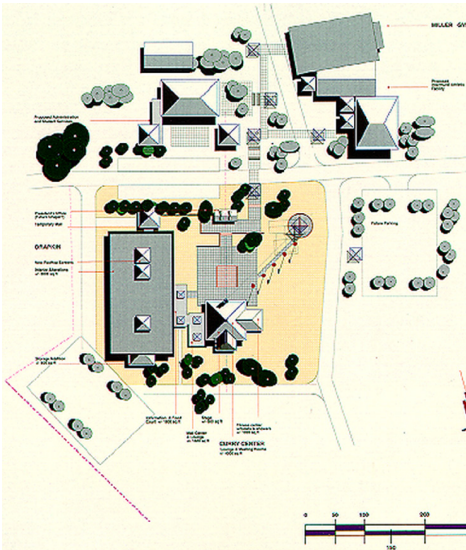


Curry College Master Planning, Student Center & Curry Center

DRA completed a Master Plan Study of the upper campus which incorporated evaluation of the student center, two academic buildings and the Dean's residence. A preliminary scheme was set forth to renovate and expand the existing Drapkin Student Center. The renovation included redesign of the existing cafeteria into a food court with the inclusion of a snack/convenience deli, a game room, book store, storage area and offices for student activities, for residence life and the Dean.

A proposed addition to the Drapkin Student Center, to be called Curry Center, was planned to accommodate a meeting/gathering space for 300, a video/TV amphitheater, a fitness center and mail room for the college. Preliminary schemes were also developed to construct interactive classrooms and a large lecture facility at the Hafer Academic Center.
